- 1985** — The SA Founder received her commission.
- 1986** — The SA Founder began the development of the SA Formation of Servants and with two others started to implement the Servant Leadership Model in their own lives.
- 1989** — The SA Founder and team started the SA Program Model as a Pilot Project in Calgary, AB.
- 1994** — The SA Founder and team started their Cooperative to house their Pilot Project's related business ventures.
- 1995** — The SA Founder and team started the SA Foundation.
- 1998** — The SA Founder and team were the catalyst to start NOW Canada in Kelowna, BC.
- 2000** — March 31, 2000 the SA Founder completed her work in the Pilot Project in Calgary and was sent by the board of the Foundation to start SA World Services Division in Vancouver.
- 2000** — The SA Founder and team modified the SA Foundation's mandate to address the replication of the SA Program Model.
- 2000** — NOW Canada was the catalyst to start SAS Surrey, BC under the leadership of the SA Founder and team and the SA Founder wrote the SA Core Values.
- 2000** — The SA Foundation, under the leadership of the SA Founder & Team, began to disseminate the SA Program Model in Developed, Developing and Underdeveloped countries.
- 2001** — SA Foundation started to fulfill its modified mandate & began its first project in a developing country in Kathmandu, Nepal. It is still financially supported by the Foundation. **(Pilot Project for Developing Countries)**
- 2005** — SA Foundation was the catalyst to start Restore New York, in NYC, New York, USA.
- 2005** — The SA Founder co-wrote the SA Principles to Live By
- 2008** — SA Foundation was the catalyst to start Generate Hope in San Diego, CA. USA.
- 2010** — SA Foundation started its recovery program, Genesis in Vancouver, BC. as a model for **Developed Countries** and the International Internship Centre of the World Services Division. It is used to train partners internationally.
- 2011** — SA Foundation provided consultation on its program model to Streets Alive, Lethbridge, AB.
- 2012** — SA Foundation provided consultation on its program model to Next Step Ministries, Calgary, AB
- 2013** — SA Foundation started its first project in an underdeveloped country in Budapest, Hungary. It is financially supported by the Foundation. **(Pilot Project for Underdeveloped Countries)**
- 2013** — SA Foundation provided consultation to the Aurora House in Grande Prairie, AB.
- 2014** — SA Foundation has 5 more European Projects (3 in Germany, 1 in Bulgaria and 1 in Greece) as well as 1 in Atlanta, Georgia in the US and 1 in Toronto, Ontario in Canada.
